On October 15 and 16, ten members of 9-11 FSA went to Washington for two days of lobbying members of the US House and Senate. We met with 61 Members and/or their staff representatives. "A+" is of course the best possible for those of us who want secure borders and meaningful government efforts to prevent more 9-11 style attacks.

"F" is the rating for those who do not represent the interests of the American citizen but rather has sold out to the special interests who promise the member campaign support.

All of the House members face re-election in less than one year.
