On June 11, speaking at a mosque in Sofia, Bulgaria, Pres. Bush restated his commitment to passage of the Kennedy-Bush Comprehensive Amnesty Bill. He told reporters: "See you at the bill signing ceremony." With these words Bush was reaffirming not only his commitment to giving amnesty to law breaking illegals, but also to reaffirming his desire to keep America's borders unsecured and to give terrorists and violent criminal aliens unhindered access to America and its citizens.

Well, a funny thing happened to Bush on the way to that bill signing...the American people got in his way and stopped his bill in the US Senate on June 28.

What former Texas Governor Ann Richards said of the first George Bush applies even more to the current President: "Poor George. He cain't hep it He was born with a silver foot in his mouth." Well on Thursday June 28, the people of America took that silver foot out of Bush's mouth and gave him a good hard kick in the behind with it.

America dodged a bullet on Thursday, but that doesn't mean any of us can rest. The wealthy people who want to destroy America's middle class aren't going to give up. The Ford Foundation, the ACLU, the Chamber of Commerce, LaRaza, MALDEF, George Soros, Catholic Charities, immigration lawyers, bankers, Western Union....all the profiteers, political extremists, race hustlers...they aren't going to quit trying to destroy the America we know. So now is NOT the time to quit fighting.

Just because those people lost on Thursday does not mean Bush is going to start securing our borders. It does NOT mean he's going to try any harder to

catch and deport illegal aliens. It does not mean he's going to try to stop Arab terrorists from walking across our borders or from getting visas from Bush's accomplices in the State Department. It doesn't mean that George Bush is going to tell his so-called "Justice Department" to stop prosecuting Border Patrol Agents for doing their jobs. It does NOT mean Bush is going to tell the "Justice Department" to start prosecuting people who employ illegals.

And because George Bush will not enforce the laws he has sworn to uphold, today, tomorrow and for a long time to come Americans are going to continue to be murdered, raped, shot, stabbed, beaten, or killed by drunk driving illegals.

To all who read this: remember the dead. Remember those Americans who were killed or whose lives were shattered by violent acts committed by people Bush claims "just want to do jobs Americans won't do." Remember the dead.
